DIRECTIONS - From Lyndon: At US 75 and K-268 junction at the round-a-bout north of Lyndon, proceed east on K-268 for seven miles. **Turn north onto Pomona Dam Road (Green Acres is across the road) and proceed 1/2 mile to E. 229th Street (just before crossing the dam). Turn right and proceed to the park area straight ahead. If you see the spillway, turn around.** From Ottawa and Garnett: North on Hwy. 59 to Ottawa to 23rd Street. Turn left. Go approximately one mile to Eisenhower Road. Turn right. Travel two miles to K-68. Turn left. Continue on K-68 for approx. 15.5 miles (K-68 turns into K-268 four miles west of Pomona). See above directions in red. Call the Extension Office if different directions are needed.
