Scholarship Application Process: The applicant must be enrolled in a two-year or four-year college/university or a vocational program. The application is form-fillable. Complete all sections and use “NA” (not applicable), if needed. The required information must be submitted on separate, one-sided pages with a 1.5” left margin and 1” top and right margins with a minimum font size of 10. If handwritten, it must be legible. Illegible forms will not be considered. Staple in the upper left-hand corner and submit the completed scholarship application packet in the numerical order listed below by **5:00 p.m. on March 22nd** to the Frontier Extension District Office, located at 411 S. Oak, in Garnett.

Scoring:

4-H Leadership – 40%

4-H Citizenship/Community Service – 30%

4-H Participation, Recognition – 20%

Non-4-H Leadership, Citizenship, Community Service, Participation, Recognition – 10%

1. Include your high school transcript or most recent college semester grades. The transcript can be unofficial and is not required to be in sealed envelope. Home school students must provide appropriate documentation for grades.
2. Include a letter of recommendation for the applicant from a non-related high school teacher, counselor, principal (not a student).
3. Include a letter of recommendation for the applicant from a non-related extension agent, assistant, or club leader/volunteer of the 4-H program.
4. Submit a one-page, single spaced summary of 4-H significant leadership, community service, participation and recognition, up to and including the **2023-2024** 4-H year. Bullet lists or tables may be used. Begin with the most recent accomplishments. Label the 4-H activities accordingly: L=local; C/D=County/ District; A/R=Area/Regional; S=State; N=National; I= International.
5. Submit a one-page essay, double-spaced, titled “How 4-H Has Impacted Me”.
6. Include a one-page, single-spaced summary of non-4-H leadership, citizenship, community service, participation and recognition in your school and community, up to and including the **2023-2024** 4-H year. Begin with the most recent accomplishments.
7. Write a short paragraph about your educational and long-term career goals.

The recipient of the Anderson County 4-H Scholarship will be presented an oversized check at the Anderson County Fair Parade during the Anderson County Fair. After **September 1st**, the scholarship winner will be expected to pick up the \$1000 check from the Frontier Extension District Office, located at 411 S. Oak, in Garnett.
