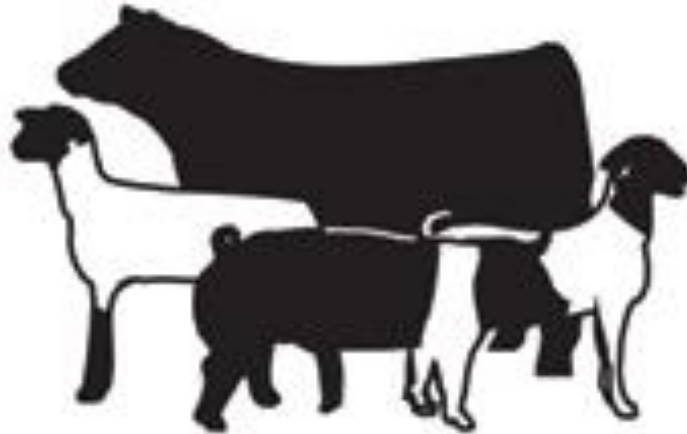

General Rules:

1. Entry fee is \$15.00 per head. There is no cost for showmanship for those already entered in a market or breeding class. Entry fee is to defray expenses of show. No refunds. Exhibitor must show his/her own animals including showmanship.
2. All entries received after April 5, 2019 will be considered late entries and will be \$30.00 per head.
3. All entries are due postmarked by April 5, 2019, to Denise King, 32415 W.95th St, De Soto, Kansas 66018. Late entries accepted day of show at \$30.00 per head. Make checks payable to Johnson County 4-H Livestock Club.
4. Show order is Breeding, Showmanship, and Market.
5. The judge's decision will be final.
6. All exhibitors must check in at the registration table prior to weighing cattle. This includes in county and out of county exhibitors in the breeding and market classes.
7. Showmanship classes will be broken by 4-H age as of January 1, 2019.
Senior – 14-18; Intermediate – 10-13; Junior 7-9.
8. All Market steers and heifers will be weighed from 7:00 a.m. – 9:00 a.m. Fairgrounds will open at 7:00 a.m. Saturday morning.
9. Johnson County 4-H beef project members who will not be showing at the Johnson County Spring Beef Show will be allowed to weigh-in and tag their animals from 6:00 – 7:00 p.m. on Friday, April 19, at the Johnson County Fairgrounds. **This includes market heifers, steers and commercial heifers.** A \$3.00 fee for each ear tag due at weigh in. (Not part of registration)
10. Market classes will be determined by breed registration, and classes will be divided by weight if warranted. Market animals without registration papers will be shown in the crossbred class.
11. Breeding classes will be broken according to breed and age. Breeding females must be born January 2018 or after. Breeding females without registration papers will be shown in the commercial class. If AOB please list on entry form, 2 or more in a breed will open a class.
12. Cattle must be manageable and be haltered and on lead rope to be eligible to weigh and show.
13. No straw or other bedding material will be used. All stalls/work area will be cleaned by the exhibitor before leaving the fairgrounds.
14. Generators are highly encouraged!
15. No mistreatment of animals will be tolerated by the show committee or the Johnson County Extension Program.
16. No animals or people will be allowed overnight on the Johnson County Fairgrounds.
17. No dogs will be allowed on the Johnson County Fairgrounds.
18. A concession stand will be provided on show day.
19. This show is a “No Fit” show, using the same rule as the State Fair and KJLS “No Fit” is defined as using no adhesive, glue, and paint or powder products.
20. Show is open to all bona fide 4-H and FFA members who are 7-18 years of age as of 1/1/19.
