**DIRECTIONS** - From Lyndon: Travel east on 268 Hwy north of Lyndon. This road will turn into 68 Hwy. Continue to just the west edge of Ottawa at Eisenhower Road. Turn right. Go to 17th Street and turn left. Go about 1 mile. Celebration Hall (CBH) will be on your right. If you get to the stop light, turn around and go back 3/4 of a block. \*\*The Armory and CBH share a driveway. CBH is a yellow-colored building and sits back off the road on the corner of 17th and Elm Streets. From Garnett: Travel north on Hwy. 59 toward Ottawa to 17th Street (3rd stoplight). Turn left. Go about 3/4 of a block. See above information at the "\*\*". Call the Extension Office if different directions are needed.
