- 3. ALL BIRDS MUST BE NPIP TESTED BEFORE THIS SHOW AND BANDED.
- 4. JUDGING OF BIRDS WILL START AFTER SHOWMANSHIP. ALL BIRDS MUST BE IN PLACE BY 9:00 A.M.

SHOWROOM WILL OPEN AT 7:00 A.M. (setup will be evening before if you would like to help 6pm)

- 5. AWARDS WILL BE GIVEN.
- 6. ENTRY FEE OF \$2.00 PER BIRD, \$3.00 for pens of three, \$2.00 a sale cage, \$2.00 for showmanship
- 7. PLEASE INDICATE SPECIFIC CLASSES: PEN OF 3, LARGE FOWL, BANTAM, WATERFOWL, OTHER (i.e. GAME BIRDS, GUIEAS, TURKEYS, PIGEONS).
- 8. JUDGING WILL BE DONE BY THE AMERICAN STANDARD OF PERFECTION.
- 9. SHOW WILL BE HELD ACCORDING TO GOVERNING RULES AND REGULATIONS.
